

Undergraduate Request for Honors Project - English 4992

To the student and instructor:

The <u>Undergraduate Bulletin</u> describes the Honors Project as "a substantial essay in literature, linguistics, folklore or film, or body of creative writing accompanied by essay; directed by two members of English faculty." The Honors Project may be taken once for three credits. Prerequisites to registering for English 4992 are senior status, good standing in the English Honors Program, a proposal submitted in writing in the preceding term, and the consent of two full-time Department of English instructors and chairperson (or designee).

In the semester prior to registering for ENG 4992, the student will submit to the Undergraduate Advisor of the Department of English a prospectus of at least one page that includes

- a date of application, student's name, and identification number;
- the academic term in which credit will be earned in ENG 4992
- the topic, theme, or problem to be investigated;
- the approach to the central concern;
- a list of readings and writing assignments;
- the deadline for submission to instructors;
- and the instructors' signatures.
