Department/College/University Requirements:

The Dietetics course sequence is 104 cr. hrs. Of these, 62 credits are in NFS courses, which include 20 cr. hrs. in supervised practice. In addition, each student shall fulfill the University proficiency and core requirements and the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences requirements as specified in the WSU Undergraduate Bulletin (Post Bachelor students are required to complete only the Dietetics course sequence). Students are advised to adhere to the outlined sequence.

Chemistry, biology, and basic nutrition and food science courses (NFS 2130, 2140, 2210) must be completed before entrance to the Coordinated Dietetics Program.
