SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS AND PREMEDICAL SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1) **DR. C. GARY ARTINIAN ENDOWED PRE-MEDICINE SCHOLARSHIP** of varying amounts (\$500-\$700), dependent upon funds available, is to limited students enrolled full-time in pre-medicine study at Wayne State. Students accepted for full-time pre-medicine study at WSU may apply. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement (a minimum 3.0 GPA) and financial need. This award must be applied toward tuition only.
- 2) **MARK AND ARLENE CHRISTENSEN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FOR MATH AND SCIENCE STUDENTS** of \$1,000 is limited to full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students majoring in mathematics or science. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement (a minimum 3.0 GPA) and financial need.
- 3) **HILDA COLEBANK ENDOWED MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** of \$1,000 is limited to full time students enrolled in pre-medicine in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement (a minimum 3.0 GPA) and need.
- 4) **HOWARD AND MARY KEHRL SCHOLARSHIP** of \$5,000 is restricted to undergraduate students majoring or intending to major in science or engineering. Students may receive this award for up to four years.
- 5) **CHRISTINA J. NEUMANN ENDOWED MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR WOMEN STUDYING SCIENCE** provides tuition for full-time undergraduate or graduate female science students. This endowed scholarship was created to honor the memory of Christina J. Neumann, a College alumna who later became an educator and advocate for breast cancer research. A minimum of one award of \$600 will be made annually.
- 6) **N.V. SHAH MEMORIAL ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP** of \$1,000 is limited to undergraduate students who are enrolled or accepted for enrollment on a full-time basis in a science or mathematics program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement (minimum 3.0 GPA) and qualities of leadership. Preference is given to students of Asian-Indian decent.
- 7) **ELLIOTT DOV STROM ENDOWED MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** of varying amounts (typically at least one award of \$700 per academic year), dependent upon funds available, is limited to students enrolled full-time who are majoring in any science or mathematics program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Recipients are selected on the basis of financial need.
- 8) **MARGARET TEAL AWARD** of \$1,000 is limited to undergraduate and graduate students who are enrolled or accepted on a full- or part-time basis in a science or mathematics program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
- 9) **ARTHUR J. WALKER MEMORIAL ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP** of \$1,000 is limited to undergraduate and graduate students who are enrolled or accepted for enrollment on a full- or part-time basis in a science or mathematics program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement (minimum 2.5 GPA) and financial need. Preference is given to minority students, specifically African Americans and Native Americans.

- 10) ZAMARRIPA FAMILY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP is limited to full-time, undergraduate students majoring in pre-medical studies in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Preference is given to minority women. Recipients must demonstrate financial need and are eligible for repeat awards as long as they continue to meet all requirements. Awards may be used for tuition or other educational expenses.
- 11) AKHILA AND C.R. RAJAMANI ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP is limited to full-time and part-time undergraduate students enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. A minimum 2.0 GPA is required. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and preference will be given to students who participate in the WSU work study program on campus. Recipients may use this award for tuition and other educational expenses.
- 12) CONGRESSWOMAN CAROLYN CHEEKS KILPATRICK ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP is limited to full-time and part-time undergraduate students enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum GPA of 2.5. Recipients may use this award for tuition and other educational expenses.
